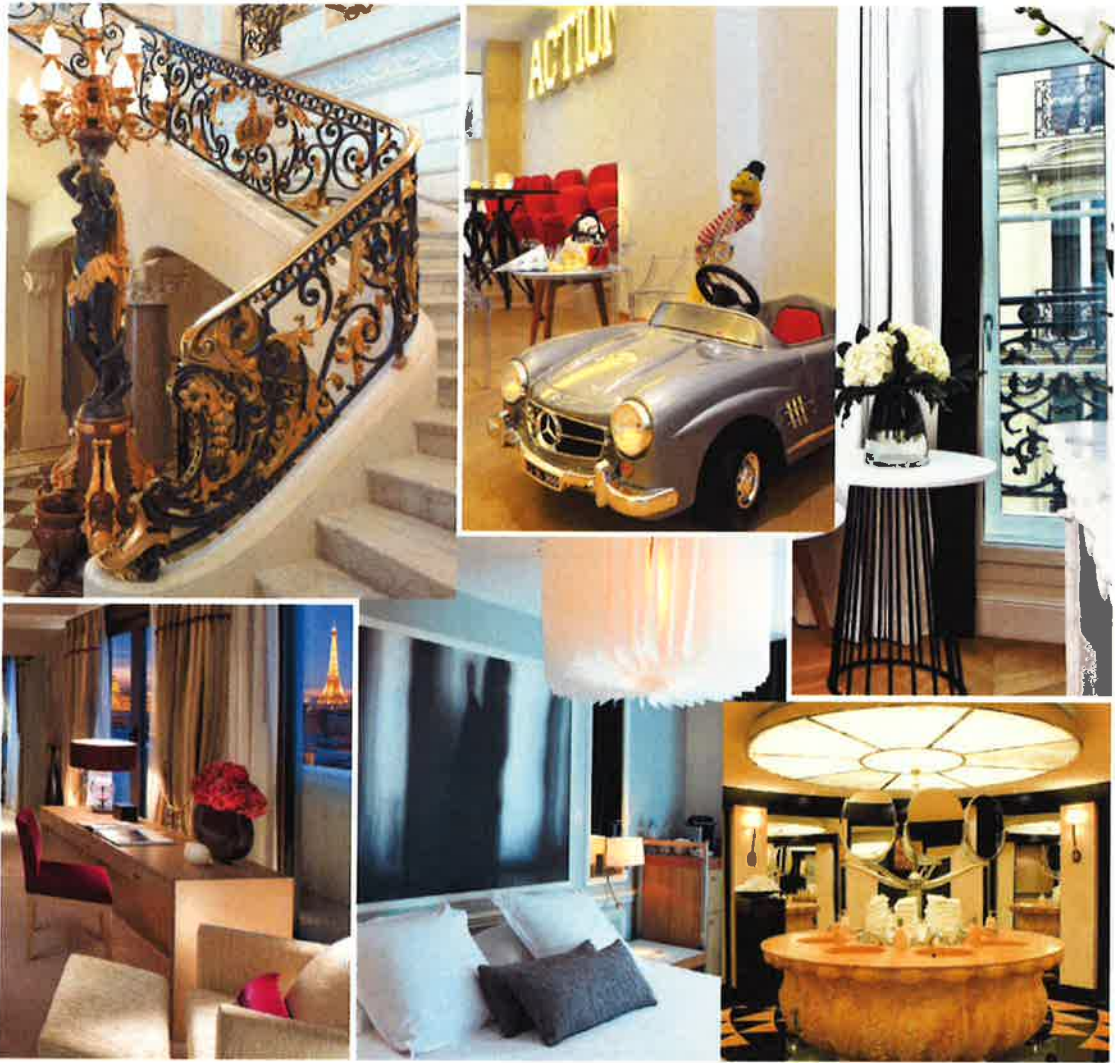

LE SWANN

Entirely dedicated to Marcel Proust and his universe, the Swann has taken up residence in the 8th arrondissement of Paris, right in the heart of the historical district of the Proustian Monceau plain and St. Augustine.



Designed by an avid admirer of Marcel Proust's work, the hotel was conceived in this new Parisian address to share his passion and the uniqueness of the Swann with all visitors. Going on an 'In Search of Lost Time' by bits, it regains strength and diversity from its people, its rich universe tinted with elegance and nostalgia along with rigorous attention to detail... This is the initiatory journey that you are offered.

Entirely renovated by architect Aude Bruguère, who is proud of its 4-star status, the Swann wants to help perpetuate a continuous hotel and literature tradition in order to revive Proust in this historic area. Tenacious bibliophile, Jacques Letertre gathered a rare set of first editions for the Swann like 'Pleasures and Days', Marcel Proust's first book, dated 1896. In the lobby, a library with more than 500 books by or on Marcel Proust, is made available in Japanese, English, German, Italian, Hungarian, Lithuanian, Danish, Spanish, etc. for clients. Each floor of the Swann is dedicated to a mythical place described in Proust's novels. We travel to Combray, Balbec, to the lounge of Verdurin in the elegant Faubourg

Saint-Germain, and to Venice and its favourite artists. The 81 rooms of Swann carry the name of characters from 'In Search of Lost Time' or famous artists that Proust admired, from Oriane de Guermantes to Anna de Noailles, with the Baron de Charlus or the painter Giotto. It exudes a Parisian, Proustian and contemporary atmosphere, which evokes a dreamy and conducive quiet, poetic halt... and inspiration. Elegant, they portray the art deco period and artistic expansion of the early twentieth century in this area. Particular attention has been paid to your well-being through enhanced insulation and bedding with a soft mattress topper of real goose feathers. And when you arrive, some sweets are waiting for you... madeleines, of course! M.A.
